CHARACTERISTICS



- Deboning food safe stainless steel chainmail tunic.
- Wire ø 0.5 mm. Rings diameter : inside 3 mm and outside 4 mm.
- Fixing points of the straps on the tunic by stainless steel plates
- Fit with a back strap and a waist strap, 100% polyurethane (food safe according to the Directive 2002/72/EC) and buckles in polyacetal
- Fit with 2x3 press-studs to fix a chainmail glove with shoulder cuff (Manulatex)
- Code 24149 dimensions L.56 x H.85 cm Suitable for operators between 148 and 165 cm and with a chest size between 90 and 120 cm $\,$

- Code 17557 - dimensions L.56 \times H.100 cm - Suitable for operators between 158 and 200 cm and with a chest size between 90 and 120 cm

Weight: 2070 g

- Code 17558 - dimensions L.56 x H.115 cm - Suitable for operators between 165 and 220 cm and with a chest size between 90 and 120 cm $\,$

APPLICATIONS:

The tunic pinafore apron is suitable in work situations where the level of risk is high, such as: When using narrow knives for deboning large carcasses OR when the tip of the knife is directed towards the body.

WASH:

Cleaning is done by vigorous brushing or by jets under pressure with hot (50 °C) soapy water or in a mixture of water and mild detergent. Rinse with water - minimum temperature of 82 °C.

Do not use toxic products for cleaning or rinsing.

For disinfection, use only products authorized by the veterinary services. The use of high doses of chlorine is not recommended. Store the tunic, after cleaning, in a dry and ventilated place.
